Yale-New Haven Hospital Trauma/General Surgery Unit

The Trauma/General Surgery Unit at Yale-New Haven Hospital offers 18 floor beds to trauma and surgical patients ranging from age 16 throughout the span of adult life. Our trauma team coordinates the care of multi-system injured patients, including motor vehicle accidents, motorcycle accidents, gunshot wounds, stab wounds, falls, and domestic violence, as well as general surgery, endocrinology surgery and oncology surgery.

Our 6-bed stepdown unit provides additional support to patients requiring special monitoring needs, including vascular, ear, nose, throat, plastics, orthopedics, transplant and interventional radiology.

The RN staff on the Trauma/General Surgery Unit represents a wide variety of experience, ranging from new graduates to nurses with 25+ years of experience — as well as 5 CN IIIs and 10 CN II.
